CHRIST THE DOOR

John 10:9

- 20 By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh;

1 Thessalonians 5:23

The very God of peace <u>sanctify you wholly</u>; and <u>I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be</u> preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.

THRONE OF GRACE - SURRENDER, FORGIVENESS & PRAYERS OF WISDOM AND DUNAMIS POWER

THE JORDAN BAPTISM

Matthew 3:13-15

- 14 But John forbad him, saying, I have need to be baptized of thee, and comest thou to me?
- 15 And Jesus answering said unto him, Suffer it to be so now: <u>for thus it becometh us to fulfil all</u> righteousness.

Philippians 3:10

That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his sufferings, <u>being</u> made conformable unto his death;

Ezekiel 47:3-5

- 3 ... he brought me through the waters; the waters were to the ankles.

Two Edged Sword - Separation of Spirit , Soul and Body

Hebrews 4:12

For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and <u>sharper than any two-edged sword</u>, <u>piercing even to</u> the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow...

The Winnowing Fork - Separation of Chaff from the Golden Wheat

Matthew 3:11-12

- 11 I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance. but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire:
- 12 Whose fan (winnowing fork) is in his hand, and he will thoroughly purge his floor, and gather his wheat into the garner; but he will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire.

Skilled Knife of Circumcision and The Axe of Light

Colossians 2:11

<u>In whom also ye are circumcised with the circumcision made without hands</u>, <u>in putting off the body of</u> the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ:

Matthew 3:10

Now also the axe is laid unto the root of the trees...

They that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles ...

He shewed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb.

- 11 Let us labor therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief.

Matthew 6:28-29. 33

- 28 Why take ye thought for raiment? <u>Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not,</u> neither do they spin:
- 29 Yet I say unto you, That even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these.
- 33 Seek first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.

Matthew 6:22-23 The Interwoven Eye

- 22 The light of the body is the eye: <u>if therefore thine eye be single</u>, thy whole body shall be full of light. But if thine eye be evil thy whole body shall be full of darkness.
 - Single Eye From root word Alpha (Christ) and Pleko (weave). The eye of faith singularly interwoven into Christ and His Rest.
 - Evil Eye (poneros) full of labors, hardships. To toil for daily subsistence.

THE THRONE OF THE FATHER'S LOVE - WHERE I AM

John 12:26

If any man serve me, let him follow me; <u>and where I am, there shall also my servant be</u>: <u>if any man</u> serve me, him will my Father honour.

John 14:2-3

- 2 In my Father's house are many mansions (dwelling places): if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.
- 3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

John 17:24

<u>Father, I will that they also, whom thou hast given me, be with me where I am; that they may behold</u> my glory, which thou hast given me: for thou lovedst me before the foundation of the world.

John 16:25

These things have I spoken unto you in proverbs: but the time cometh, when I shall no more speak unto you in proverbs (mysteries), but I shall shew you plainly of (opening show, reveal) the Father.

THE FACE OF GOD - ACCESSING THE RESURRECTION LIFE

Matthew 17:1-2 (Mark 9, Luke 9)

- 1 After six days Jesus taketh Peter, James, and John his brother, and bringeth them up into an high mountain apart,
- 2 And <u>was transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light.</u>

John 1:14

The Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, <u>and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only</u> begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

- 1 Corinthians 15:49-57
- 49 As we have borne the image of the earthy, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly.
- 50 Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption.
- 51 Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,
- 52 <u>In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead</u> shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.
- 53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.
- 54 So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, <u>Death is swallowed up in victory.</u>
- 55 O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory?
- 56 The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law.
- 57 But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

2 Corinthians 3:18

We all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.

Romans 8:11, 17-19, 29-30

- 11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, <u>he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.</u>
- <u>17 If children, then heirs; heirs of God, and joint-heirs with Christ</u>; if so be that we suffer with him, <u>that we may be also glorified together.</u>
- 18 For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared <u>with the glory which shall be revealed in us.</u>
- 19 For the earnest expectation of the creature waiteth for the manifestation of the sons of God.
- 29 For whom he did foreknow, <u>he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son</u>, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.
- 30 Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.

Isaiah 60:1-2

- 1 Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the LORD is risen upon thee.
- 2 For, behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people: <u>but the LORD shall</u> <u>arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen upon thee.</u>

Philippians 3:20-21

- 20 For our conversation (citizenship) is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ:
- 21 Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body, according to the working whereby he is able even to subdue all things unto himself.

1 Corinthians 10:4

All did drink the same spiritual drink: <u>for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that</u> Rock was Christ.

- 8 Then said he unto me, These waters issue out toward the east country, and go down into the desert, and go into the sea: which being brought forth into the sea (Dead Sea), the waters shall be healed.
- 9 And it shall come to pass, <u>that everything that liveth</u>, <u>which moveth</u>, <u>whithersoever the rivers shall come</u>, <u>shall live</u>: and <u>there shall be a very great multitude of fish</u>, <u>because these waters shall come thither:</u> <u>for they shall be healed</u>; <u>and everything shall live whither the river cometh</u>.

THE FACE OF GOD - THE CROWNING OF THE CHURCH

Ephesians 2:4-6

- 4 But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us,
- 5 Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;)
- 6 And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus:

Hebrews 2:6-8

- 6 But one in a certain place testified, saying, What is man, that thou art mindful of him? or the son of man, that thou visitest him?
- 7 Thou madest him a little lower than the angels; thou crownedst him with glory and honour, and didst set him over the works of thy hands:
- 8 Thou hast put all things in subjection under his feet ...

Revelation 3:7-8, 11

- 7 To the angel of the church in Philadelphia write; These things saith he that is holy, <u>he that is true</u>, <u>he that hath the key of David</u>, <u>he that openeth</u>, and <u>no man shutteth</u>; and <u>shutteth</u>, and <u>no man openeth</u>; 8 I know thy works: behold, <u>I have set before thee an open door</u>, and <u>no man can shut it</u>: for thou hast a little strength, and hast kept my word, and hast not denied my name.
- 11 Behold, I come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man take thy crown.

Revelation 5:5-6, 12

- 5 And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.
- 6 And I beheld, and, lo, in the midst of the throne and of the four beasts, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as it had been slain, <u>having seven horns and seven eyes</u>, which are the seven Spirits of God sent forth into all the earth.
- 9 And they sung a new song, saying, Thou art worthy to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain, and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation;
- 10 And hast made us unto our God kings and priests: and we shall reign on the earth.
- 11 And I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels round about the throne and the beasts and the elders: and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands;
- 12 Saying with a loud voice, <u>Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honour, and glory, and blessing.</u>

Zechariah 6:10-13

- 10 Take of them of the captivity, even of Heldai, of Tobijah, and of Jedaiah, which are come from Babylon, and come thou the same day, and go into the house of Josiah the son of Zephaniah;
- 11 Then take silver and gold, and make crowns, and set them upon the head of Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest;
- 12 And speak unto him, saying, Thus speaketh the LORD of hosts, saying, Behold the man whose name is The BRANCH; and he shall grow up out of his place, and he shall build the temple of the LORD:
- 13 Even he shall build the temple of the LORD; and he shall bear the glory, and shall sit and rule upon his throne; and he shall be a priest upon his throne: and the counsel of peace shall be between them both.

Psalms 21:1-3

- 1 To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. The king shall joy in thy strength, O LORD; and in thy salvation how greatly shall he rejoice!
- 2 Thou hast given him his heart's desire, and hast not withholden the request of his lips. Selah.
- 3 For thou preventest (meetest) him with the blessings of goodness: thou settest a crown of pure gold on his head.

Zechariah 4:9-10

- 9 <u>The hands of Zerubbabel have laid the foundation of this house</u>; <u>his hands also finish it</u>; and thou shalt know that the LORD of hosts hath sent me unto you.
- 10 For who hath despised the day of small things? <u>for they shall rejoice</u>, and shall see the plummet in the hand of Zerubbabel with those seven; they are the eyes of the LORD, which run to and fro through the whole earth.
